



Working Safely

This course trains workers to ensure that their actions contribute to Health and Safety in the workplace and that individual responsibilities are clearly understood.

The working safely syllabus concentrates on:

- Identifying hazards and risks
- Preparing Risk Assessments
- Defining safe working conditions
- Safety of equipment/machines
- Electrical and Fire Safety
- Accident Reports

The course will assist workers in complying with the requirements for control in safety management and alert them to co-operate with managers in safety activities to improve the organisation's safety performance.

By the end of the course delegates will have a good understanding of their responsibilities and those placed upon the employer. Delegates will be fully briefed in the requirements of major safety legislation and standards, so they will understand the need to formulate and implement effective Health and Safety procedures within their organisation.

Delegates are required to undertake a written and practical assessment.

Successful candidates will receive an IOSH Working Safely Certificate.

Managing Safely

This course is approved by the Institute of Occupational Safety and Health (IOSH) and is designed for those who wish to improve Health and Safety standards within their organisation.

The course will cover relevant issues likely to affect 'working safely' including:

- Define hazards and risks
- Implement schedules for active monitoring and analysing records
- Health and Safety legislation / Codes of Practice
- Active monitoring (Inspections, Checks and Audits)
- Procedures and techniques used in management reviews
- Accident and incident investigation

The course will also cover the main provisions of Health and Safety at work incorporating the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations.

At the conclusion of the course delegates are required to undertake a multi-format assessment. Delegates must complete their project and return it to the tutor within 10 days of the course completion date.

On successful completion of this course, delegates will have an understanding of the legal requirements for risk assessment and be able to identify hazards both generally and from their organisation's perspective.

Successful candidates will receive an IOSH Managing Safely Certificate
